# **Programs**

**AARP Experience Corps** engaged more than 160 adults age 50+ to tutor students in grades K-3 during the 2013-2014 school year. Volunteers tutored 875 students in 14 Cleveland Metropolitan School District buildings to help them learn critical literacy skills.





**My Mentor My Friend** matched caring adult volunteers to do this lunchtime mentoring with 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students in four Cleveland schools. The mentored students showed improvement in attendance, academic attitude, social skills and self-esteem.


